- 3 The NCLT vide its order dated 23rd June 2023 (Certified Copy Received on 30th June, 2023) has approved the resolution plan submitted by the consortium comprising of Ashdan Properties Private Limited, Classic Promoters & Builders Private Limited and Atul Builders (Successful Resolution Applicant) in the CIRP of D S Kulkarni Developers Limited.  
Pursuant to the approved resolution plan, the existing fully paid up 2,58,01,008 equity shares of Rs. 10/- each aggregating to Rs. 25,80,10,080 were extinguished with effect from 27th September 2023 and 1,00,00,000 equity shares of Rs. 10 each aggregating to Rs. 10,00,00,000/- were allotted to the resolution applicant and its affiliates and public as per the plan.  
Thereafter Company has initiated the process of Extinguishment of entire Existing Share Capital of the Company including Corporate Action and Intimation to Exchange however the same in process of approval as on the date of the approval of financial results.
- 4 The original standalone financial statements of the Company for the year ended March 31, 2023 approved by the Resolution Professional (RP) on May 29, 2023 were circulated to the shareholders for adoption in the Annual General Meeting held on 28th December, 2023.
